

## **ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **ISSUE AND LISTING OF NEW UNITS UNDER THE DISTRIBUTION REINVESTMENT PLAN**

*3 December 2014* - Mapletree Industrial Trust Management Ltd., as manager (the “Manager”) of Mapletree Industrial Trust (“MIT”), wishes to announce that it will issue 15,891,813 new units in MIT (“New Units”) at an issue price of S\$1.3876 per Unit pursuant to MIT’s distribution reinvestment plan (“DRP”) in respect of MIT’s distribution for the Second Quarter Financial Year 2014/2015 from 1 July 2014 to 30 September 2014 (the “2QFY14/15 Distribution”) on 4 December 2014.

The New Units will be credited by 4 December 2014 to securities accounts of MIT unitholders (“Unitholders”) who have elected to participate in the DRP. The New Units will commence trading on the Main Board of Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (“SGX-ST”) at 9.00 a.m. on 4 December 2014.

The new Units will rank *pari passu* in all respects with the existing Units.

Following the issuance of the New Units, the total number of MIT Units in issue has increased from 1,716,406,768 to 1,732,298,581.

Unitholders who did not elect or partially elected to participate in the DRP and overseas Unitholders who did not provide registered addresses in Singapore to The Central Depository (Pte) Limited, will receive their respective entitlements to the 2QFY14/15 Distribution in cash on 4 December 2014.
