

Mapletree Industrial Trust Extends Track Record in Build-to-Suit Data Centres

Mapletree Industrial Trust ("MIT") has secured a new build-to-suit ("BTS") project for an estimated development cost of S\$60 million. The six-storey BTS data centre will be developed and fully leased to an established data centre operator. MIT has been allocated a plot of land in the West Region of Singapore by JTC Corporation for the development. The site is located in a specialised industrial park for data centres with ready-built infrastructure catered to support multinational companies and enterprises.

SUMMARY OF BTS PROJECT



- Development of a six-storey BTS data centre in the West Region of Singapore
- ➤ Gross floor area: About 242,000 square feet ("sq ft")
- Land area: About 96,800 sq ft
- Land use zone: Business 2
- Land lease tenure: 30 years
- Expected cost: About S\$60 million
- Completion date: 2nd half of 2018
- ■ Agreement to build and lease:
 - 100% committed by an established data centre operator
 - Initial lease term of >10 years
 - Staggered rental escalations
